## Dyett of Montserrat.

John Dyett, planter. Will dated 25 March 1739. My wife Ann £100 c. for the purchase of negros for her maintenance and a cow. My s. Wm. £40 c. s. John £10 c., sons Rich<sup>d</sup>, Rob<sup>t</sup>, and David. My eldest dau. Ann, daus. Eliz., Sarah, Mary, Jane, and Rachel 1 negro each. Bedingfield Bramley, Esq., Capt. Wm. Wyke, and Wm. Fox, gent., Ex'ors in Trust. Sworn 21 July 1739. (Montserrat Records, Vol. of Transcripts made in 1793.)

Henry Dyett of London, Merchant, about to depart for the W.I. Will dated 9 March 1803. To my wife Elinor £250 a year, furniture and plate, with permission to reside on either of my estates in Montserrat, if she care to return to the W.I. My dau. Elinor £2,000. Having settled on my dau. Sarah Sophia £1500 at her marriage with Tho. Furlonge, Esq., I give her £500 more. My dau. Frances Maria £2000. My daus. Eliza, Ann and Martha, £2000 apiece at 21 or marriage. My granddau. Ellenor, dau. of my son Richard, £500. My sister Frances Musgrave £50 a year. My niece Sarah Musgrave £100. My niece Ann Underwood £100. My nieces Sarah and Frances Duberry £30 c. a year. My cousin Sarah Duberry £33 c. a year. To my son Richard my house in the town of Plymouth called Swindells. The bond of £1000 I gave him. All residue to my sons Richard, Henry and Mark (last not 21). My brothers Mark Dyett and Joshua Dyett of Montserrat, and my nephew Henry Iles Underwood of Demerary, merchant, etc., Ex'ors.

*1st Codicil*, 23 July 1803. About to depart for G.B. My son Richard has another dau. Mary. The £500 to go to her and Elinor equally.

*2nd Codicil*, of Copthall Court, merchant, 17 Jan. 1804.

Sworn 24 Nov. 1804, testator late of Brompton, deceased. (768, Heseltine.)

1712. Losses by the Freuch Invasion in July. Norward Division. Robert Dyett £8.

1729. Census. Rich<sup>d</sup> Dyett, planter, of S<sup>t</sup> Anthony, and John Dyett, fisherman, of S<sup>t</sup> Peters.

1764, Jan. Tho. Duberry, Esq; at Montserrat. ("G.M.," 46.)

1769, Feb. 11. Cath. Morphy leases to Edw. Roberts and Robert Dyett 21 negros for 7 years at £211 c. rent. Valuation £1681 c. (Montserrat Records, No. 1952, p. 509.)

1798. Tho. Oliver of London, Esq., conveys to Henry Dyett of Montserrat, Esq., a plantation called Buggy Hole in M. In a previous deed of 1796, Eleanor wife of the said Henry Dyett was named. Rich<sup>d</sup> Dyett of M., Esq., a witness. (Close Roll.)

1804, June 16. At Brompton, Henry Dyett, esq. ("G.M.," 693.)

1814, May. At Vere-cottage, near Taunton, the eldest dau. of the late Henry Dyott, esq. of the Island of M. (*Ibid.*, 521.)

1818. Henry Dyett and Henry Dyett the y<sup>r</sup> of London held a mortgage of Farrells for £30,000. (Deed *penes* R.H.K. Dyett of Antigua.)

1834, April. Lately. At Chiswick, aged 78, Elinor, widow of H. Dyott, esq. ("G.M.," 452.)

1852. Henry Dyett appointed Postmaster of M. in May, and still holding the office in 1879.

1912. On 30th April, at Port of Spain, Trinidad, the Hon. William C. L. Dyett, Unofficial Member of the Legislative Council.

Ann, died 27 Aug. 1807, aged 48. M.I.

Richard Dyett of Montserrat, Esq., born there 4 Sept. 1776; died 11 Jan. 1808, aged 32. M.I. in South Transept of St. Anthony. Frances Dyett, 1st cousin, born 30 Nov. 1777; died 17 Aug. 1822. M.I. Henry Dyett, born in Montserrat 13 Sept. 1782; of London 1818 and 1823, merchant; died in Canada 16 Dec. 1832. Harriet Ross, mar. 1807; died in Canada in 1832; had twelve children. Mark Dyett, born in Montserrat 4 Sept. 1787?; a minor 1803; settled in Demerara. Elinor, born in Montserrat 26 June 1778; died at Taunton 5 Feb. 1814.

A pedigree of Dyot of Lichfield was recorded in the Visitation of Staffordshire in 1663, but there is no clue in it to the W.I.

Sarah Dyett m. in 1785, at St George's, Antigua, Tho. Rogers, Esq., but nothing is known of her origin.



Richard Dyett of St. Anthony's District, planter; in Census of 1729 then owned a house, 4 negroes, 3 cows, and 2 hogs. = Sarah Underwood, mar. 28 Sept. 1725 at St. Anthony. Robert = Anne Dunbar, mar. Dyett. 21 Sept. 1727 at St. Anthony.

Richard Dyett, bapt. 27 May 1728 at St. Anthony; signed the proclamation of George III. in 1760; Esq. in 1798. = . . . , dau. Eleanor, bapt. 14 July (? 1726) at St. Anthony.\* of . . . Blake.

Mark = Mary, Dyett, Chief Justice of Montserrat 1804. died 21 Jan. 1807, aged 54. M.I. = Anna Montserrat, Esq., sworn a J.P. in Antigua 1812; died there in 1827; partner 1796 with Chr. Musgrave. Sarah, mar. . . . Duberry, and had issue. Frances, mar. 1785 Chr. Musgrave, sometime of New York; M. of C. of Montserrat 1792, where he died Nov. 1797. His will dated 29 June 1796; recorded in 1800. She was alive in 1811 and died at Antigua.

\* On looking at the transcript in Vol. I., p. 43, it will be noticed that the baptisms are not in correct sequence and the years are doubtfully divided.

† There was a Henry Dyett who was, I understand, son of one Mark Dyett, probably the old Chief Justice, a lawyer, Puisne Judge of Montserrat. He married and had a son Mark (who was a drunken fellow), and who married a Mary Graham, afterwards Mary White, manager of the Col. Bank, Antigua; and a daughter Elizabeth, who married John Dobridge of Montserrat, and has descendants living. After Henry Dyett's lawful wife died he got hold of a black slave woman named Barbara Brownbill (whom he got from St. Kitts), and by her he had several children and founded the coloured "Dyetts," or rather "Brownbills" family, now at Montserrat. Edward Bowman "Dyett," a coloured lawyer of distinction, was one of his sons by B. Brownbill. Another coloured son was Henry, a solicitor, of Montserrat, and this Henry's son Edward Farley Dyett (or rather Brownbill) is the Hon. E. F. Dyett of Montserrat. (R.H.K.D.)

The Hon. E. F. Dyett, Acting Commissioner, died 12 July 1915.
